Special Conditions

1. A statement of account revealing the following information to be forwarded to the District Officer Suva within sixty days (60) from the drawing date of the lottery :-
 - A) Total amount raised by the sales ticket;
 - B) Total amount expended on expenses;
 - C) Total amount of prize money paid;
 - D) A list of prize money paid;
 - E) Total amount spent on charitable purposes;
 - F) A list of all unsold tickets.

2. No lottery ticket shall be sold by any person under the age of sixteen years.

3. The names of prizes winner to be published in a newspaper in Fiji within seven days from the drawing date of the lottery.

4. Collect 10% turnover tax on lottery tickets sales and pay the same to the Commissioner Inland Revenue Department within 28 days from closing date of the sales of lottery tickets.
